Conditional Offer Letter for MBBS admission

We refer to your application for admission as a foreign student in the MBBS course for the session 2025–2026 under Dhaka University at Bangladesh Medical College.

We are pleased to inform you that you have been provisionally selected for admission to the MBBS course at Bangladesh Medical College for the session 2025–2026. This is subject to the approval of the Directorate General of Medical Education (DGME), Bangladesh.

Bangladesh Medical College is the (Estd.1986) first and best non-government medical college in Bangladesh. It is approved by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, affiliated with the University of Dhaka, recognized by the Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council (BM&DC), and listed in IMED (International Medical Education Directory) & WHO (World Health Organization).

The duration of the course is 5 (five) years, followed by a 1-year internship. The total tuition fee for the 5-year MBBS course is USD 49,000. Additional charges will apply as per the rules of the Government of Bangladesh and Dhaka University. At the time of admission, students are required to pay USD 25,000. The remaining amount should be paid in four equal annual installments of USD 6,000 each over the next four years. **Please note that hostel charges are not included in this fee.**

Students who fail to complete the course within 5 (five) years will be required to pay extra fees as per institutional rules.

You are requested to pay USD 10,000 by 30.09.2025 to reserve your seat (this amount will be adjusted against the first payment). The payment should be made via T.T. to:
